
"A Church That Listens: Doing Theology from the Existential Peripheries"

As part of the *Doing Theology from the Existential Peripheries* project in 2022, Catholic theologians all over the world were asked to go to the margins of the church and society to listen. Dr. Owens Jofré will amplify the voices she heard in Southern California–first generation immigrant community organizers, women in ministry for divorced and widowed Catholics, young gay Catholic men, a vowed religious woman who started an intentional community near the border to accompany migrants, and a deconvert from Catholicism. She will provide snapshots of the experiences of those she met, sharing resources well-suited for teaching and ministry.
